The Job

Reporting to the Lands Manager, this position is responsible for participating in various planning sessions including the Old Crow Flats Special Management Area, North Yukon Planning Commission, Peel Watershed Planning Commission, Ni'iinlii' Njik Committee of Managing Agencies, North Yukon Fish and Wildlife Management Plan, and the North Richardson Mountain Dall Sheep Management Plan. This position also liaises with people working on harvesting issues, forestry, the porcupine caribou herd, climate change, recycling, youth and natural resources, energy, permafrost, and ecological monitoring. The position also has the responsibility to share information with and educate community members on natural resources and environmental issues and trends.
